Instructions to Candidate

Julia is a 70-year-old female.

Referred by her family doctor after complaining of blurred vision for the past month. Also complains of seeing double while getting out of bed in the morning.

Has not had an eye exam for the last eight years.

IN THE NEXT 24 MINUTES:

- YOU WILL HAVE TWO (2) MINUTES ONCE YOU ENTER THE STATION TO PREPARE YOURSELF AND BECOME FAMILIAR WITH THE STATION EQUIPMENT
